




#### **Household Profile**






## Level of Employment

# High number of ET-HH residents have a High School diploma




HIGHEST LEVEL OF EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

## **Barriers to Employment**

16% of ET-HH adults report that they face challenges in finding and keeping work

#### Top 5 challenges to finding and/or keeping work

- 1. Lack of job skills/training (33%)
- 2. Affordable childcare (26%)
- 3. Disability (26%)
- 4. No job opportunities available in the area (26%)
- 5. Transportation (26%)

# Top 5 Non-health services needed by ET-HH households at this time

- 1. Budgeting/Financial Literacy/Credit Repair (20%)
- 2. Assistance applying for public benefits (WIC, SNAP, TANF, etc.) (17%)
- 3. Childcare/Early Learning Programs (13%)
- 4. Homeownership Counseling (11%)
- 5. Assistance with household errands (e.g. grocery shopping) (11%)
- 13% of parents said that their children would participate in job training/employment programs and/or learning trades/apprenticeships if they were available
