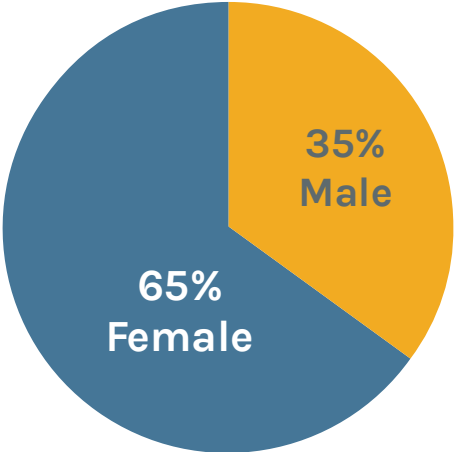

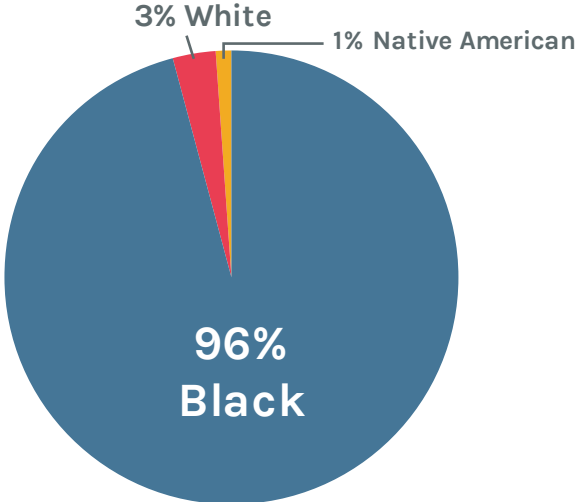

### Gender Distribution



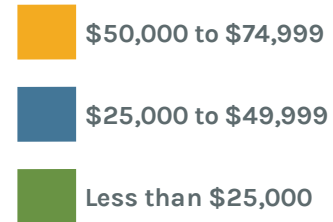
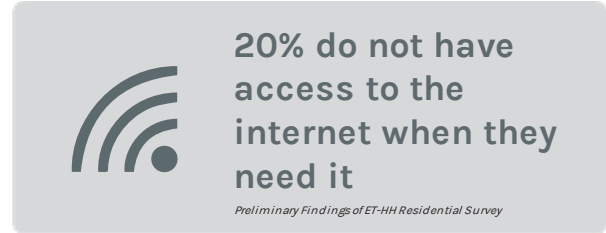
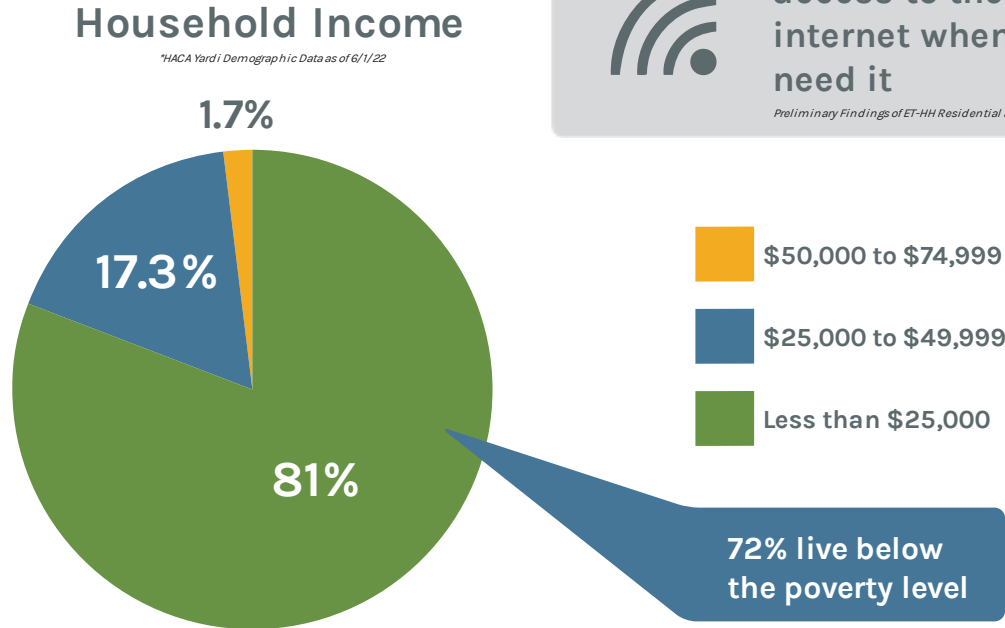
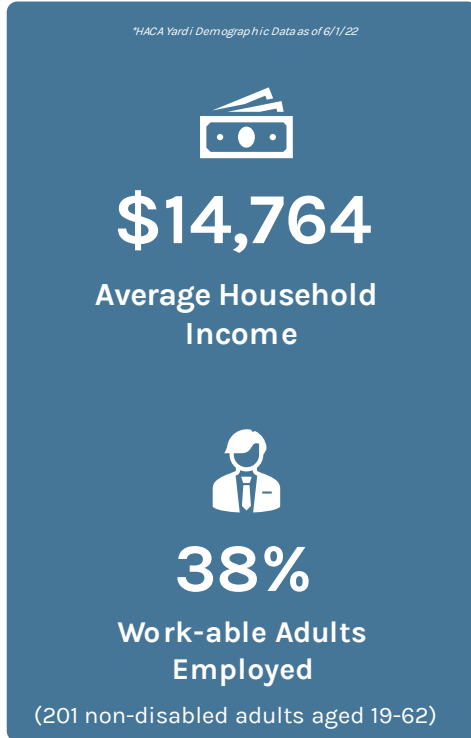

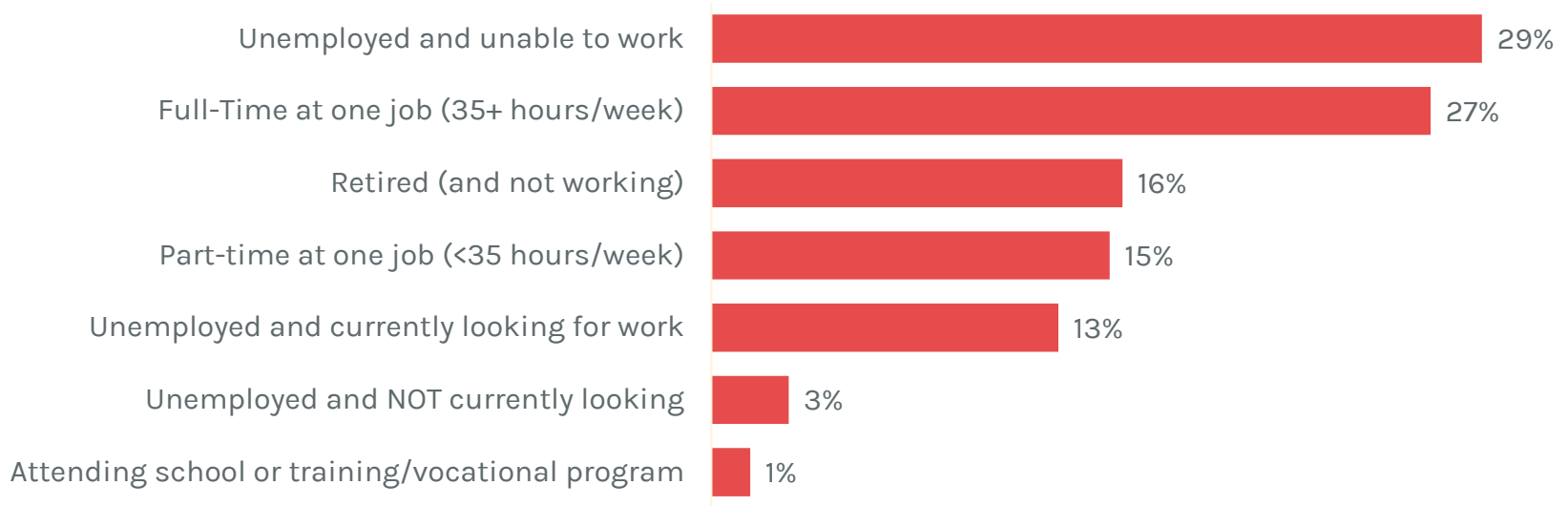

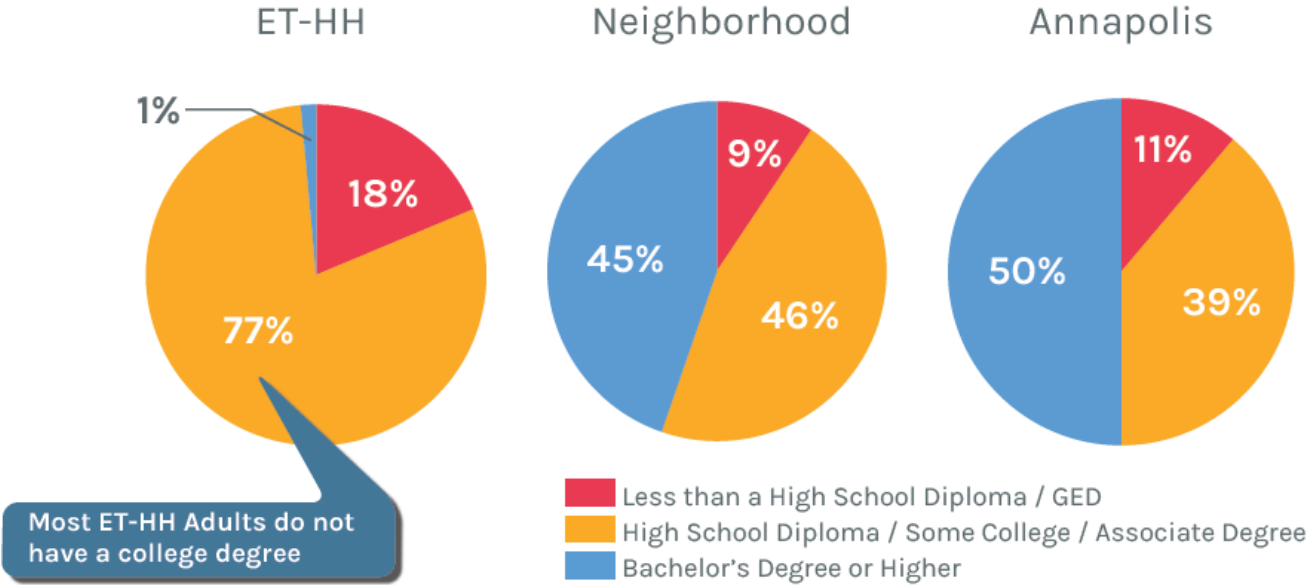
# Level of Employment

# High number of ET-HH residents have a High School diploma



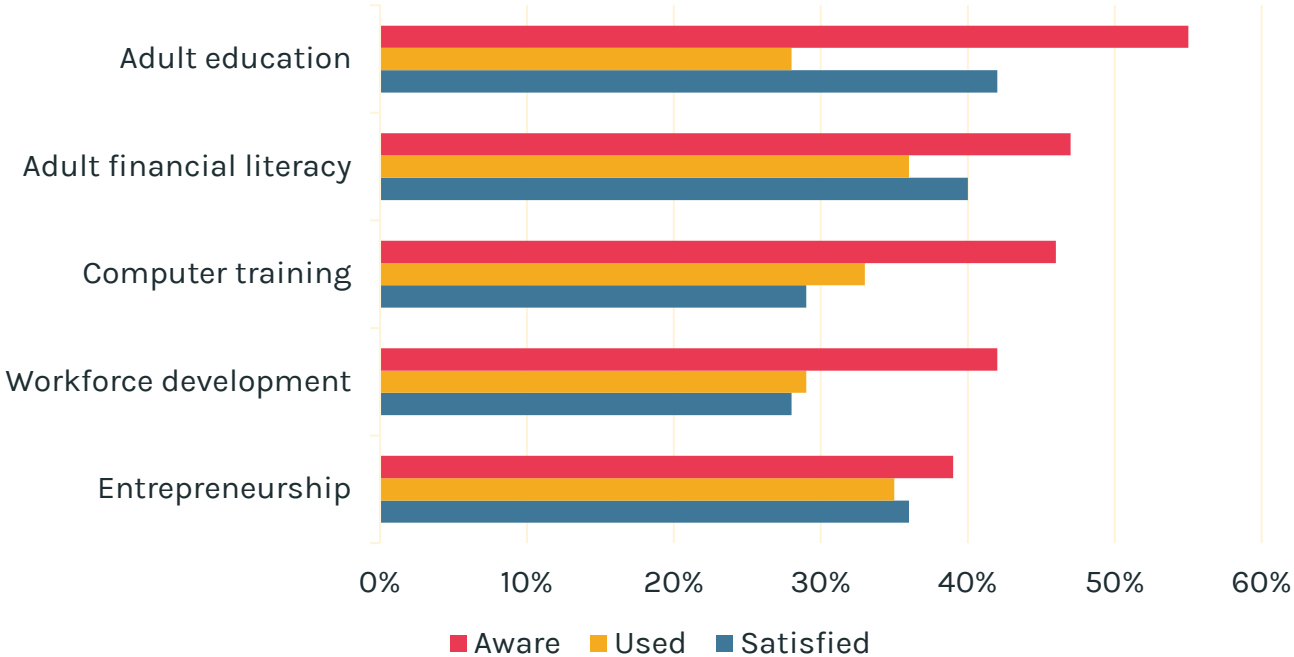
## HIGHEST LEVEL OF EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

# Barriers to Employment

**16%** of ET-HH adults report that they face challenges in finding and keeping work

## Top 5 challenges to finding and/or keeping work

1. Lack of job skills/training (33%)
2. Affordable childcare (26%)
3. Disability (26%)
4. No job opportunities available in the area (26%)
5. Transportation (26%)

# Top 5 Non-health services needed by ET-HH households at this time

1. Budgeting/Financial Literacy/Credit Repair (20%)
2. Assistance applying for public benefits (WIC, SNAP, TANF, etc.) (17%)
3. Childcare/Early Learning Programs (13%)
4. Homeownership Counseling (11%)
5. Assistance with household errands (e.g. grocery shopping) (11%)

**13%** of parents said that their children would participate in job training/employment programs and/or learning trades/apprenticeships if they were available
