






Overall, Part 1 violent crimes and property crimes have decreased in the Eastport CNI Neighborhood over the past 2 years

Crime Category	2021 (Annualized)	2022	Change
Crimes Against People*	41	29	-30%
Crimes Against Property**	87	67	-23%





Both ET-HH and Neighborhood residents FEEL less safe in the evening, but ET-HH respondents also FEEL less safe during the daytime.




Gap between how families think about the frequency of crime ("How often does crime occur in the neighborhood?")



Parents are concerned about their children's safety







57% of parents feel that their children are somewhat unsafe walking to/from school/bus stop.

Top 5 choices for IMPROVING COMMUNITY HEALTH AND SAFETY

- **1. COMMUNITY VIOLENCE INTERVENTION** (CVI) (reducing gun violence with tools other than incarceration) (54%)
- 2. COMMUNITY-LED SAFETY PROGRAMS (street captains, safe passage, community walks, neighborhood notification apps) (51%)
- 3. Address barriers to **ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES** (good paying jobs, job pipeline) (48%)
- 4. Frequent or VISIBLE POLICE patrols (43%)
- 5. More COMMUNITY-BUILDING events and activities (33%)
