Youth and Community Meetings Summary

PRESENTATION OF PLAN ELEMENTS

April 17 + 18, 2023



On April 17th and 18th, Task Force members, residents from Eastport Terrace-Harbour House (ET-HH) and the surrounding Eastport neighborhood, and other stakeholders convened for a series of workshops to review and comment on Plan Elements for the Eastport CNI neighborhood. Three meetings were held:

- 1) a Young Planners workshop on the afternoon of April 17, 2023 outside the Eastport Community Center,
- 2) an in-person public meeting on the evening of April 17, 2023 at the Eastport United Methodist Church, and
- 3) a virtual (Zoom) public meeting on the evening of April 18, 2023.

The agenda and meeting content were identical in both evening sessions, and Spanish interpreters were available. The in-person and virtual sessions were held to maximize opportunities for participation.





6 YOUTH PARTICIPANTS

During the Young Planners workshop, ET-HH youth previewed the concept gateway park and housing site plan and provided feedback on design elements from their perspective. Young Planners illustrated and annotated various design elements that they would like to see included with the redevelopment to create a new sense of place.

At both the in-person and virtual public evening sessions, members of the planning team presented the proposed conceptual site plan along with goals and strategies from the Plan, including redeveloping equitably and sustainably, investing in family success, and reconnecting people and places. The Plan Elements represented the synthesis of ideas and strategies that emerged from all of the community engagement and public participation efforts throughout the planning process. Participants at both sessions were then invited to ask questions and give feedback, and to affirm if the proposed Plan Elements responded to the residents and the community.
